

Post Falls Urban Renewal Agency Approves Streets and Parking Lot Project

The Agency recently approved funding the revitalization of Frederic and William streets for one block each between 4th Ave. and Railroad Ave. The work will be similar to the improvements on 4th Ave. east of Spokane Street, and include curbs, sidewalks, decorative street lights and repaving. Also included in the project was the revitalization of the public Centennial Trail parking lot along the BNSF railroad tracks located north of 4th Ave. and west of Spokane Street. This project will include installation of curbs, sidewalk, lighting and landscaping. Engineering is being provided under contract with Welch / Comer Engineers and a construction contract has been awarded to Owens Construction, both firms being from Coeur d' Alene, Idaho.
